### **Curriculum Overview**

Introductory Spanish is a web-based curriculum created by Voces Digital intended for middle school students who are just beginning their language-learning journey. Students explore the various cultures of the Spanish-speaking world through vibrant photos, interesting cultural notes, compelling videos, and interactive panoramas. These resources focus on and contextualize high-frequency vocabulary, preparing students to communicate with native

speakers. Our goal is for students to explore and appreciate the Spanish language and the cultures where the language is spoken.

### **Cultural Integration**

Holiday traditions, cuisine, music, public transportation, weather, and other themes provide a window into the Spanish-speaking world while also relating to students' lives, helping to pique their curiosity. Authentic materials and interview videos give students real-world experiences of the culture and help to develop their cultural comparison skills. While increasing their proficiency in the language, students learn to ask more complex questions and explore what life is like in other parts of the world.

If you answered boots and sandals, you are correct! Words that look and sound alike in English and Spanish are called cognates. Cognates can help you understand what a word means by just looking at it. What other Spanish clothing words that look like English words can you find on your vocabulary list? What are you wearing? In Spanish, we ask:

✓ "¿Qué ropa llevas?" (informal)

¿Qué ropa lleva usted?" (formal)

You answer with 🦽 "Yo llevo..."

The thematic vocabulary words introduced at the start of each chapter provide a foundation for proficiency in the language and prepare students to explore the chapter themes. Interactive activities reinforce the vocabulary in a variety of contexts. As students progress through this title, they'll build their knowledge, increase their confidence, and solidify their interest in continuing their Spanish studies.
